Minutes of St Kew Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 10th March 2015 at 7.30 pm in St Kew Parish Hall

884. County Councillor and Police Reports

PCSO Drennan gave the crime figures for February (2) and mentioned the theft of heating oil in the area. She will also investigate lack of speed signage at Pendoggett, and that she had managed to get Cormac to pay for the Neighbourhood Watch signs that had been removed. Cllr Knightley remarked that the community bus was not being well used from St Kew and that he would continue with his surgery despite poor numbers.
