## Minutes of the Meeting of St Kew Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2019 at 7.00 pm in St Kew Parish Hall

### 6159. Public Discussion

### 6161. Cornwall Councillor and Police Reports

Cormac have confirmed the road closure for the works to the bridge by Skisdon. Positioning of restricted access for large vehicles/HGV's is required to avoid issues on the narrow road past St Kew Inn. Cornwall Council has accepted the waste collection proposals for the new service starting in 2021. The Wadebridge area community network meeting is on 12 September, and P Bishop agreed to attend for the Parish Council.

**6171. Co-Option of Parish Councillor**

Mr Antony Prophet has expressed an interest in becoming a Parish Councillor as there are currently 2 vacancies on the Parish Council.

**Cllr Bishop** reported that there was a lot of litter in the area after the recent hedgecutting.

**Cllr Bishop** had visited Mr Bromfield and taken pictures of the works being carried out at his property.

**Cllr Rowe** reported that there is a substantial amount of hedge cuttings left outside St Catherine's, St Kew Highway which could be classed as fly tipping.

**ACTION:** Clerk to write to the owner of St Catherine's to request the cuttings are disposed of appropriately.

**Cllr Rowe** has asked if parishioners can be asked to be considerate to farmers when walking dogs on footpaths that go across the farmer's fields as dog waste can contribute to diseases affecting farm animals.

**ACTION:** Cllr R Godden to write an article to go into the Parish Magazine.

**Cllr R Godden** reported that shrubs beside the St Kew Inn have now been cut back as requested at the last meeting.

**Cllr R Godden** reported that the grass cuttings in the top Churchyard are now being disposed of correctly in the Lower Churchyard.
