Chairmans Report

Councillor Richard Godden thanked his fellow Councillors for their support during the past year, which has been reasonably uneventful. He reported that support has been given to several organisations in the Parish in the form of grants. These include The Parish Hall, The Parish Magazine and the three defibrillators sited at Chapel Amble, St Kew and St Kew Highway. A new notice board and signpost for Trelill has been commissioned.

He thanked County Councillor Knightley for his support over the year and remarked how he was pleased in what the Parish Council has achieved without raising the precept.

He thanked Mr J Godden and Mr J Parnell for their work on remaking and replacing the signpost at Trelill, and said that it should be noted that the cost amounted to only £65.00.

The Chairman told County Councillor Knightley about the edge of the road slipping into the stream at the bridge in St Kew.

Devon and Cornwall Police Report

There were no police representatives present and no information had been received as to statistics over the last year.

Cornwall Councillors Reports.

County Councillor Knightley praised St Kew Parish Council for the way it conducted its business and was always pleased to attend the meetings. He remarked that the Parish Council really worked for the benefit of the local community. He referred to budget restraints

and how finances were even more stretched than before, and that next year there would have to be choices in the Cornwall Council in what they are able to support and what they will be unable to provide.

He said that he thought that Parish Councils would have to take a greater role especially in road maintenance etc.

Public Discussion

A member of the public raised the point that potholes were being repaired correctly now, but Cormac are still spraying tar on some of them. County Knightley informed him that spray tar is used as a quick repair, as Cornwall Council is liable for damage caused after 48 hours of reporting a defect. The hole can then be repaired correctly at a later date.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 19.55
